RATIONALE

Based on the Renewed EU Agenda for Higher Education (HE) in 2017, higher education institutions need to be "more inclusive, not just institutions with ivory towers". The EU focuses on the link between HE and their communities by introducing the concept of "civic university". This concept aims to provide a theoretical model for socially responsible institutions and at the same time to allow students' development regarding their social and civic competences.
